ABOUT THE DIPLOMAS

WHAT ARE THE DELF DALF DIPLOMAS?

DELF is the Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française (Diploma of French-language studies) and DALF is the Diplôme Approfondi de Langue Française (Advanced Diploma in French language). These diplomas are awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify the level of French-language skills of non-French speakers. The diplomas are valid for life and recognised all around the world. To obtain them, you must take the DELF and DALF examinations, which assess your communication skills in real situations using authentic documents. Students can certify their level of French with an internationally recognizable credential, meet French university language requirements, gain job opportunities, increase their confidence and fluency in French, and refresh their comprehension of the French language.

DELF DALF PREPARATION

Our DELF and DALF exam preparation courses familiarize students with the DELF DALF exam process, and assists students to recognize the methods used in different parts of the exam.

These exam preparation courses are based on the DELF DALF exam standards and all students have practice sessions with customized correction and feedback. We provide general French instruction in the mornings and dedicated exam preparation in the afternoons. Every student works to his/her level and is provided with a personal education plan. If students do not take the exam during their stay, students may send examples of work from the course book which will be corrected and returned with feedback.

Our DELF examiners are highly trained and experienced instructors, so that students are confident and well-prepared to take the DELF DALF exam at the conclusion of the course.

DELF LEVELS A1 - B1

DELF A1 BEGINNER

BASIC USER

Choose DELF A1 if you can:

- introduce yourself and others
- recognize and use everyday expressions and phrases
- answer and ask questions about personal details, e.g., where you live, things you have, people you know, etc.
- ask and answer simple questions
- write a brief postcard

DELF A2 PRE-INTERMEDIATE

BASIC USER

Choose DELF A2 if you can:

- describe your daily life including work, family, meals, hobbies
- execute daily routines such go to a shop, get information, take transit
- understand a personal letter and respond (to invite, thank, apologise)
- talk about a past event
- talk about your preferences and why you like/dislike something

DELF B1 INTERMEDIATE


INDEPENDENT USER

Choose DELF B1 if you can:

- identify the main points of a text or audio
- give your opinion, reasons, and plans on a topic briefly
- write a text on personal interest topics
- explain your dreams, hopes, ambitions, and experiences to others
- express your feelings, agreement or dissatisfaction
- organise a presentation or discussion in a logical order

DELF B2 UPPER INTERMEDIATE

INDEPENDENT USER

Choose DELF B2 if you can:

- understand the fundamental ideas of a complex text
- communicate with a degree of fluency and spontaneity
- defend an opinion and give reasons and examples
- correct yourself when you make an error
- produce detailed texts on a wide range of subjects
- take notes

DALF C1 ADVANCED

PROFICIENT USER

Choose DALF C1 if you can:

- understand a variety of demanding longer texts and conversations, and recognize implicit meaning
- use the language effectively and flexibly in social, academic and professional situations
- express yourself spontaneously and fluently without much apparent searching for words
- write detailed texts on a wide range of complex subjects

DALF C2 PROFICIENT

PROFICIENT USER

Choose DALF C2 if you can:

- understand almost everything, read, write and speak with ease
- convey subtleties accurately using a wide range of modalities with accuracy
- master idiomatic and colloquial expressions with awareness of connotations
- backtrack and rephrase a difficulty smoothly
- differentiate precise meanings of words, sentences, and paragraphs
